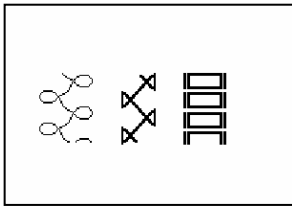


Fagotting

This decorative technique joins two pieces of fabric or lace leaving a space in between to allow for stitches. The fabric edges may be corded or folded. This technique also works well when attaching decorative lace to fabric.

Machine Settings:



Foot: Satin Foot F

Foot Pressure: 3

Needle Thread: All-Purpose Thread

Bobbin Thread: All-Purpose Thread



1. Fold under a 1.8 cm (5/8") hem on one side of each piece of cotton.
2. Turn over the fabrics, arrange so that the edges are a consistent 4 mm (1/8") apart and tape the tracing paper to the wrong side of the fabric.
3. Position the fabric under the foot with right sides up. Align the center mark of the satin foot with the center of the opening.
4. Start sewing between the edges. Gently peel the paper off after stitching is completed.
