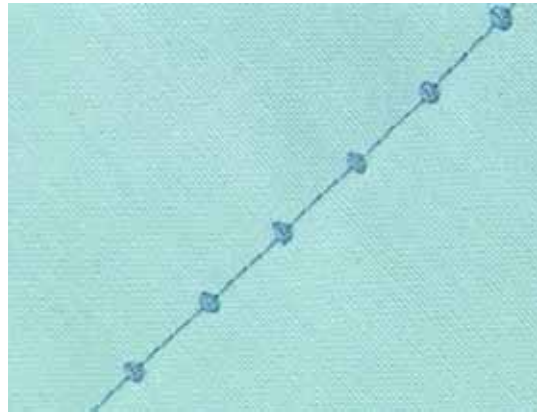
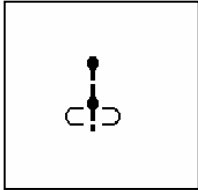


French Knots

Customarily sewn by hand, French knots can be created on Memory Craft models. They can be stitched as borders and as well as outline detailing on heirloom projects.

Machine Settings:



Foot: Beading Foot (optional foot) or Satin Foot F

Foot Pressure: 1 - 2

Needle Position: Center

Stitch Length: 2.0 - 2.4

Thread Tension: 4.0 - 6.0

Needle Thread: All-Purpose Thread

Bobbin Thread: All-Purpose Thread

Tear-Away Stabilizer

1. Draw an outline on the right side of the fabric. Place the fabric on top of the stabilizer.
2. Select the French knot stitch. Set stitch length between 2.0 - 2.4, and tension between 4.0 - 6.0.
3. Place the fabric under the foot and start sewing.

Tips:

- * To maintain the knot shape, do not turn the fabric while the knot is stitching. Turn when the straight stitches are being sewn.
- * To make hand-look stitching, stitch on a quilt sandwich using clear monofilament thread as the needle thread and all-purpose thread as the bobbin thread, and set the thread tension between 6.0 - 9.0.
