
## **Hand-Look Quilting**

## Machine Settings:









Foot: Satin Stitch Foot F2 (Open Toe) or

Satin Stitch Foot F

Foot Pressure: 3

Needle Position: Center Stitch Length: 2.5 - 5.0 Stitch Tension: 6.0 - 9.0

Needle Thread: Clear Monofilament Thread Bobbin Thread: Cotton or All-Purpose Thread

- 1. Thread the needle with the monofilament thread and wind the cotton or all-purpose thread onto the bobbin. Sandwich the batting between the two layers of cotton.
- 2. Select the Sculpture stitch. Press the Adjust key. Set thread tension between 6.0 9.0.
- 3. If the bobbin thread is not pulled up sufficiently to the top layer, you can tighten the top tension further.
- 4. Place the quilt sandwich under the foot. Start sewing.

## Tips:

- \* The stitch length may be adjusted to change the appearance of the sculpture stitches.
- You can use the same thread for both the upper and bobbin thread to stitch decorative lines on a linen blouse.
